Dear Friends in Christ,

I don't really know anyone who enjoys waiting. I struggle with it, and goodness knows the other people who live in my house do, too. In fact, we live in a society where waiting seems to be actively discouraged. We can order our pizza or other take-out food ahead, to be picked up at our convenience. We can buy items without leaving home – just the click on a button on the website of our choosing. Often times, we can even pay for overnight shipping. And I can't count the number of times in the day that I microwave a dinner, or a snack, or just some water for my tea. Waiting seems almost countercultural in the world of 2023.

I have to admit, all this convenience has its advantages. And yet, I wonder if all the instant gratification society offers has left us missing something. Because waiting offers some really important benefits. Sometimes waiting to let a situation develop allows us to better understand it, and gives us the knowledge and perspective to respond in the most appropriate way. The perseverance we develop through waiting helps us build our capacity – our emotional, spiritual, and physical muscles – as we spend time practicing whatever it is we're working toward. And sometimes, simply stopping and waiting forces us to clear our minds from the busy-ness we've created and listen for what's going on in the world around us. Or perhaps more frightening, to listen for what's going on inside ourselves.

Every year, the church calendar begins with Advent - that four-week period that comes before Christmas. Advent is the Church's invitation to practice Holy Waiting - to anticipate the birth of the Christ Child on Christmas - where the God who was present at the beginning of Creation took on human form. We're invited to slow down. To think about what it means to join all our ancestors in faith who waited on God - whether it was the Israelites enslaved in Egypt, the people of Jerusalem who were taken to Babylon, or the apostles huddling in the upper room. Because the reality is that we're often waiting on God, too. Waiting for a test result. For a job offer.

For whatever prayers we want to have answered.

Advent invites us to a time of contemplation. If we're unaccustomed to stillness, we might find the quiet unsettling. But if we persevere, we might just realize that as we wait for the coming of the Messiah – both at Christmas, and in our own lives – we might find new routines and habits that lead to a closer relationship with the God on whom we are always waiting, and yet who is ever present.

My prayer for you this Advent is that your Holy Waiting will draw you closer to the Ever Present God and will sustain your hope for the future that God is always drawing us into.

contributions!


Food Shelf:


